Who are U.S. trademark filers

- Previously focused on customers w/counsel or pro se
 - Currently ~25%
- But who really are they
 - Our data offers insight



Who are U.S. Trademark filers



Value of a US trademark registration

- Commonly known values
- Not so commonly known values
 - First-time filers have double the revenue growth
 - 13% vs. 6% per year
 - vs. comparable firms that don't file for trademark protection
 - After five years,
 - 50% higher revenues for trademark filers
 - 80% higher employment for firms filing TM applications



Value of registration, cont.

- Not so commonly known values, cont.
 - Majority of "IP-intensive industries" were found to be trademark-intensive
 - Of 210 industries considered, 110 are trademark-intensive
 - v. 70 utility patent-intensive and 13 copyright-intensive industries

- Why
 - Customer requests
 - Currently printing 5-8k weekly
 - Benefits
- When:
 - For initial applications filed on/after May 31, 2022 (target date)
- What:
 - eReg Certs will be issued with a digital seal
 - Presentation copies still available
- Comment period closed January 14, 2022
